After graduated from Columbia College-Hollywood, Saito studied under Norman Scott Powell, the producer of the TV series "24". His first work "TRIANGULATION POINT" won the Audience Award and Jury Award at Short Shorts Film Festival 2004. From 2006 Saito has been being base in Tokyo and made his feature debut on "Re:Play- Girls" in 2010. His documentary film "Instant Pet House" won the Sliver Award and Bronze Award in Direct session, and also Bronze Award in Design session of Cannes Lions 2012. His commercial film "Penguin Navi" won Sliver Award and Bronze Award in Mobile session in 2013 and Gold Award in Design session of Cannes Lions in 2014. In 2015 his short film "Gotham Jumble Parfait" won Audience Award again at Short Shorts Film Festival, and was screened at over 20 international film festivals. His another short film "Shabu Shabu Spirt" won Award of Merit at The Indie FEST Film Awards (America), and was screened at over 40 international film festivals around the world.
